- 1. All notes are half the values in the original. Whole moved up from F major to C major.
- 2. Converted to 2 staffs. New Soprano = old *Tenor*, moved up 1 octave; Alto = *Medius*, down; Tenor = *Cantus*, down; Bass = *Bassus*.
- 3. Measure 4, *Alto*: First note (E) whole note in original, changed to half note.
- 4. Some *Bass* notes moved down one octave to put them below *Tenor*.
- 5. Adjustments to words to make them fit music.
