Editorial Notes

This edition is based on the
Liber Primus Sacrarum Cantionum Quinque Vocum
Published in London 25 October 1589.

This is part one of a two part motet,
the second part of this motet is Civitas Sancti Tui.

The text is from Isiah 64:9

Do not be angry beyond measure, O Lord; do not remember our sins for ever.
Oh look upon us, we pray for we are all your people.

The initial bar indicates some of the characteristics of the original publication:

This edition has been transposed up one tone from the original;
The lozenge note indicates the rhythmic value of the initial note,
and shows that time values have been halved in this edition;
The time signature indicates the original time signature;
The stemless crotchets (quarter notes) indicate the
range for each voice part in this transposed edition;
Slurs are editorial.

Latin word spellings have been modernised.
Text in *italics* identifies text which in the original
is indicated with repeat marks.

All normal accidentals are as in the original.
Accidentals above the staff are editorial and suggested by context.
Accidentals in parenthesis are cautionary and editorial.
