



# Sancta Maria succerre miseris

## THOMAS CRECQUILLON

This piece for four voices is the final item in the second book of Girolamo Scotto's collection *Motetti del Laberinto*. In the *Cantus* partbook, it bears the rubric *Canon. Si ascendero in coelum tu illis es. Si descendero in infernum ad es* ("If I ascend to heaven, you are there. If I descend to hell, you are there" - Ps 139, v.8). The opening four notes are shown, transposed down a twelfth, in the bass clef. The interpretation of this is that the piece can be sung either with the *Cantus* part as written, or with the part transposed down a twelfth – both alternatives are written out here.

## Either the Cantus or the Bass II part should be sung, not both.
