

Carlisle (Psalm 29)

Transcribed from Ravenscroft, *The Whole Booke of Psalmes*, 1621.

Cantus

1. Give to the Lord, ye potentates, Give ye with one accord, All praise and honor, might and strength, Un-to the li-ving Lord.
2. Give glory to his holy name, And ho-nor him a-lone; Give worship to his ma-jes-ty, With-in his ho-ly throne.

Medius

3. His voice doth rule the waters all, As he him-self doth please; He doth prepare the thun-der-claps, And go-vern all the seas.
4. The voice of God is of great force, And won-drous ex-cel-lent: It is most mighty in ef-fect, And most mag-ni-fi-cent.
