Commentary:

Virgo prudentissima is an Antiphon for the Magnificat in the Vespers of Assumptionis Beatae Virginis Mariae. The setting published here is from an untitled manuscript choir book: BSB Mus.ms. 52 in Bayerische staatsbibliotek. The setting is unascribed in the Ms. but according to Bente (M. BENTE, Neue Wege der Quellenkritik und die Biographie Ludwig Senfls. Ein Beitrag zur Musikgeschichte des Reformationszeitalters(Wiesbaden,1968).) it is probably by Ludwig Senfl. The melodic material used in this setting closely resembles a variant chant-melody of this Antiphon in a Manuscript Antiphonarium in Bayerische staatsbibliotek.

The Setting of the Antiphon is notated in chiavetti in the sources and in the first mode transposed to (g g-dorian). Although a transposition downwards is in accord with early 16.th century performance praxis the original pitch is retained in this edition. The note-values are also kept as in the originals. The text-underlay follow the source closely thus giving the performers freedom and incentive to try different solutions. Ficta are added but sparingly, mainly at cadential points.
