Editorial accidentals are placed above the notes concerned.

Ligatures are denoted by the sign .

Repeat signs in the underlay of source A (see below) have been expanded in italics.

## Notes on the Readings of Source A

**B, C, and D** have been consulted, but since they are essentially identical to **A**, and were probably copied from it, they have not been collated below. It may be noted, however, that in both bars 36 and 37 **D** explicitly cancels both C sharps in the Tenor with a natural for the following note.

In the list of readings below the order within each entry is: 1) bar number(s); 2) voice; 3) reading of the source.
