


3. We will assay and go in now, His tabernacle there: Before His footstool to fall down, Upon our knees in fear. Arise, O Lord, arise, I say,


1. Nor climb upon my bed, Nor let my temples take their rest, Nor the eyes in my head.


3. Unto Thy resting place: Both Thou and the ark of Thy strength, The presence of Thy grace.
