Text by Joseph Hall (1574-1656),  
Dean of Worcester (later Bishop of Norwich):

which maketh all the saints and angels blest:  
Lo, there the Godhead's radiant throne,  
like to ten thousand suns in one.

Lo, there thy Saviour dear in glory dight,  
adored of all the powers of heaven bright.  
Lo, there that head that bled with thorny wound  
shines ever with celestial glory crowned;  
that hand that held the scornful reed  
makes all the fiends infernal dread.

Those feet, once fastened to the cursed tree,  
trample on death and hell, in glorious glee.  
Those lips, once drenched with gall, do make  
with their dread doom the world to quake.

that never can be seen by mortal eyes:  
And when thou seest this state divine,  
think that it is, or shall be, thine.
